

## Historical Notes

- 1154 Henry II comes to the throne and makes Becket Archdeacon of Canterbury  
1155 Becket made Chancellor  
1158-60 Becket a general and treaty-maker in France  
1162 Becket made Archbishop, resigns Chancellorship  
1164 Becket exiled  
1166-69 Becket excommunicates Royal Councillors and Bishops  
1170, July Henry, threatened by the Pope, is reconciled with Becket  
December Becket returns via Woodstock and Harrow, and is murdered at Canterbury  
1172 Becket canonized, and Henry II does penance at Becket's shrine

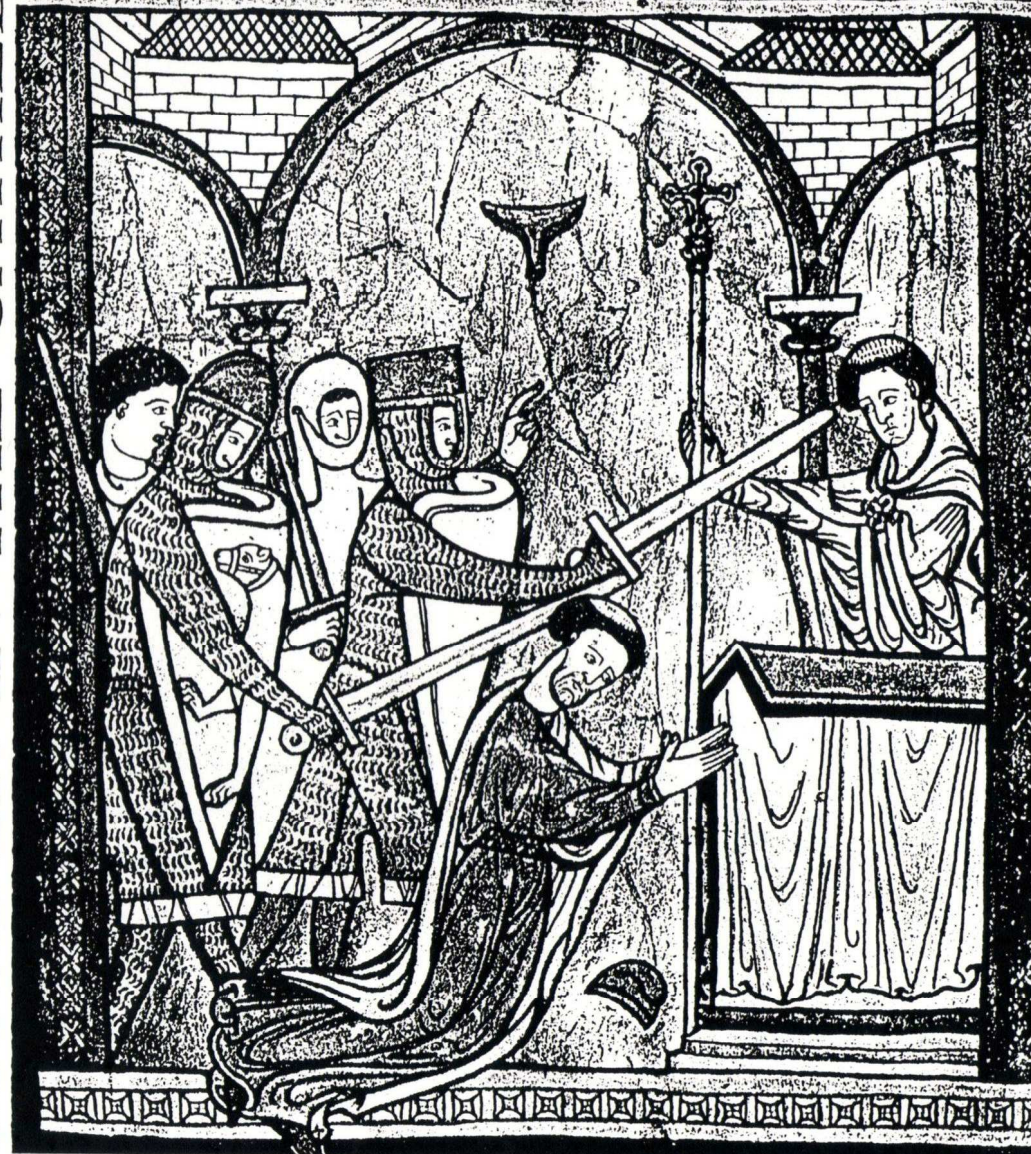
