Summer Readings

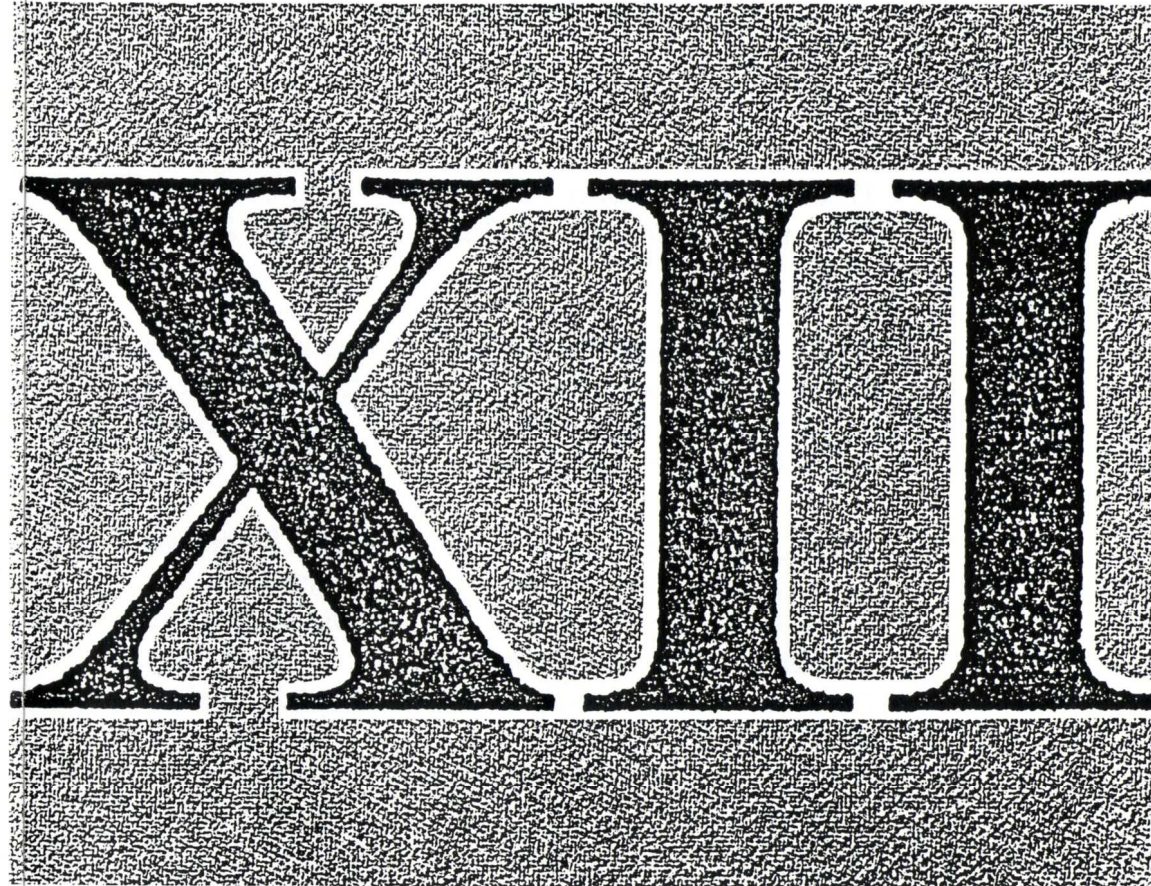
