The Big Knife by Clifford Odets is a bitter attack on the Hollywood "star system" in the heyday of the "Silver Screen".

The Play was written after Odets returned from an unhappy period as a screenwriter in one of the major Hollywood Studios.

Charlie Castle is a big star, controlled by the studio and attempting to protect the remains of his talent, integrity and personal life in the face of the demands of the sinister head of the studio, his involvement with two other women, the advice of his business managers, and a guilty secret which can destroy him, and those whom he loves.

A talented cast is led by Roderick Jones as "Charlie Castle" and includes both established Proscenium players and exciting newcomers.
