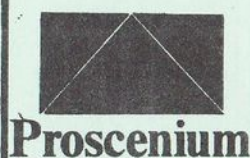

They are joined by a manservant and a male secretary and during that evening and the following morning they make forays into the no man's land lying between time present and time remembered, between truth and falsehood, between success and failure, between reality and imagination.

This is the ground where Harold Pinter's talent flourishes, the world of the footstep on the stair, the cold grey dawn, the world of the hangover and the belly-laugh, the empty land that lies between Chalk Farm and Hampstead.
