

This is PROSCENIUM's first promenade performance, in a joint production with TRILOGY (formed, in this instance from students of the Salvatorian College and St. Dominic's Sixth Form College).



This performance is based on the recent National Theatre production, a version by Tony Harrison, shown on Channel 4 at Christmas). THE MYSTERIES will be performed in a most appropriate setting - The Tithe Barn, Headstone Manor, which will become Harrow's Heritage and Museum Centre shortly afterwards.

Presented in conjunction with Harrow Arts Council, this is probably the first amateur production of THE MYSTERIES.

The mystery plays were put together by the craftsmen of the Middle Ages, inspired by the vivid stories in the New and Old Testaments, from the Creation through to the Passion and beyond.

Earthy, moving, sometimes funny, sometimes sad, always vibrant and pithy, the plays were enacted with a rumbustious naiveté which paradoxically enhances them.

Tony Harrison's modern treatment of these mediaeval mystery plays retains all of these qualities and offers us a wholehearted celebration of Man's relationship with his Maker.
