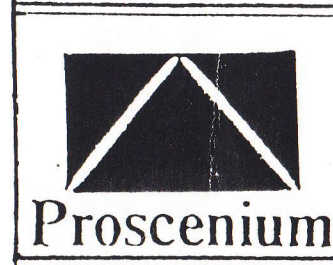

The Ancient Greek legend of Antigone lives on nearly 2500 years after the Theban plays of Sophocles were first performed.

Jean Anouilh wrote this modern version of the classic drama to be staged in wartime Paris in 1942. French audiences could acclaim the young woman's cause and the Germans would applaud the case for dictatorial power.

For this production, a short prologue offers a glimpse of Antigone's last memories of Oedipus and Polynices - before Anouilh took up the story.
