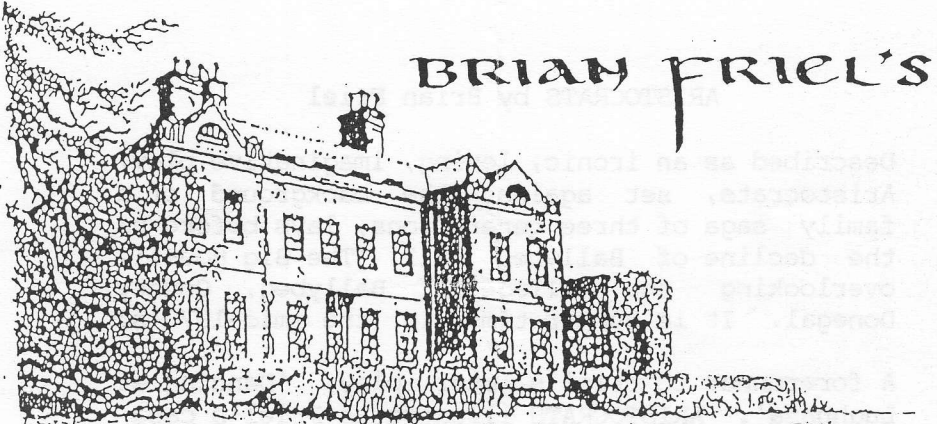

## ARISTOCRATS by Brian Friel

Described as an ironic, loving, imaginative play. Aristocrats, set against the background of a family saga of three generations, lays before us the decline of Ballybeg Hall, 'The Big House', overlooking the village of Ballybeg, County Donegal. It is summer-time in the mid-1970's.

A forerunner to Friel's later play, 'Dancing at Lughnasa'. ARISTOCRATS illustrates Friel's capacity for humour, compassion, and poetry.

ARISTOCRATS, first produced by The Abbey Theatre in 1979, won the Evening Standard Award for Best Play (1988) and the New York Drama Critics Award for Best Foreign Play (1989).
