The play in which Shakespeare's most famous character, Sir John Falstaff, leaves the Court and travels to Windsor - there to lay his hands on some money and fall - the two things are co-existent - in love.

Shakespeare leaves behind his kings and princes, the politics, the foreign fields and feuding families to paint an evocative picture of the honest burghers of the English middle class at work and at play.

He also draws on his own Stratford-on-Avon background to show the inter-reaction of town and country people and the wealth of eccentricity in a small community.

Samul Johnson said of the play, 'Its general power is such that perhaps it never yet had a reader or a spectator who did not think it too soon at an end.'
