

A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM by William Shakespeare

Although set in Athens, this is one of Shakespeare's most English plays. Its created world is based on the environs of Stratford-on-Avon, and the characters - whether tradesmen, lords and ladies, folk-lore creatures like fairies and Robin Goodfellow - are those which surrounded him as he grew up. It is a play about love and aspiration. About romance thwarted by opposition. About comedy and confusion. The theme of how all of this comes together is one of concord,....the harmony which permits the existence of diversity. The play is a symbol of the possibility of a unity which is not sameness, an agreement that can be disagreement.
